Alessandro has undergone an intensive rehabilitative neuropsychiatric treatment with Neurofeedback training program between May 2008 through July 2008. The training was geared to improving both his academic skills and his fine motor skills and coordination.


Alessandro's EEG activity was monitored during his Neurobiofeedback sessions; he used a laptop that was fitted with Italian Math Didascola (IMD) CDs. Other CDs were tried too and were not as successful as when he used the IMD CD. The results were as follow:

- Alessandro demonstrated high level of performance with the use of IMD CD. He was able to sustain attention and concentration continuously for an hour at a time. In addition, he showed great knowledge on how to maneuver use the laptop effectively.
- Alessandro did poorly with the other CD's and he was unable to sustain attention and became distracted.

To summarize, by the end of the Neurobiofeedback program, Alessandro showed improvement and much more proficient in Italian and Math.

We therefore highly recommend the use of computers and teaching aids such as Didascola Software – Bari – Italy, which encourage a stress free learning and improve concentration without anxiety, stress, or fatigue. I believe that this program will allow him to become more confident and develop a higher self-esteem.
